TRAIL CONSTRUCTION NEWS

Tate Landscaping was awarded the contract for construction on Big Bear Pen Mountain. They began work in March. At this point they have completed the side trail from the big staircase on Big Bear Pen Road to the main trail and have completed construction of the main trail from the second horseshoe curve to the big view. They are about 45% complete and should finish in August, 2011.



The volunteer crews are currently working on the connector between Big Bear Pen Road and the Kelsey Trail. They will return to work on the Historical Society trail as soon as rock is available for steps. This should be either the June or July work trip.
